Tasting notes by our cellar master (March 2020):

Colour: bright, deep, purple.

Nose: very charming and refined. Fresh, fruity, underpinned by a note of French oak, Morello cherry jam, violet. Spicy notes on aeration. **Palate:** clean attack, silky tannins. A pleasurable wine, delicious, subtle and seductive. Beautiful harmony and elegant femininity.

Blend:

- 68% Merlot Noir
- 17% Cabernet Sauvignon
- 13% Petit Verdot
- 2% Cabernet Franc

Our commitment:

Madame de Beaucaillou 2019 will age for **twelve months** in Bordeaux barrels, **20% in new oak** and the balance in one-year barrels (twelve months).

Oak of certified French origin, naturally dried outdoors for a guaranteed minimum of three years.

Regular topping-up during the first six months, racking every two or three months with a total of four rackings.

Sterile bottling under inert gas will take place in June/July 2021. 49 mm natural cork.
